Leslye lives in Blacksburg, VA with three long-haired dachshunds.

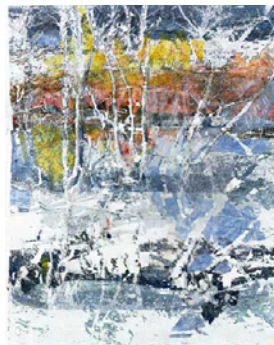
